THE ACADEMY MODEL

ACADEMY PROGRAMMING INCLUDES THE FOLLOWING:



MONTHLY ACADEMIES

Monthly programming over four years for youth in foster care focused on academics and life skills while they are in high school.

CAREGIVER ENGAGEMENT

Seminars and workshops that provide tools to caregivers to become advocates for their youth.

SUMMER ACADEMY

Intensive 2-4 week residential enrichment program on a university campus.

VIRTUAL ENGAGEMENT

Weekly mentoring and tutoring sessions, as well as an open environment to connect and build community through virtual hangouts.

FIRST STAR NATIONAL STEAM ACADEMY

STEAM ACADEMY

Virtual Tech Talks and access to labs that focus on Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts, and Math.



SCHOLAR ADVISORY COMMITTEE (SAC)

Leadership opportunity for scholars focused on becoming civically engaged and enacting change in their local communities.



ALUMNI PROGRAM

Offered to scholars who graduate the Academy as a resource during their transition to adulthood.

FIRST STAR ALUMNI PROGRAM

The First Star Alumni Program's goal is to remain connected and ensure Alumni have access to resources and the First Star network as they transition into adulthood, career, and advanced education.

FIRST STAR STUDENT ADVISORY COMMITTEE (SAC)





National Graduating Class










RACE AND ETHNICITY



LIFE SKILLS AND SELF DISCOVERY

Motivational speaker encouraged Scholars to reflect on their personal "mochila" — a symbolic backpack that represents the experiences, values, cultural roots, and tools they carry with them every day.

HEALTH AND WELLBEING

Scholars attended a Spa night to encourage self-care and wellbeing. Scholars participated in a meal planning and budgeting workshop to learn how to create realistic healthy meals. Scholars completed a workshop on recognizing the consequences of risky behavior. They also spent time reflecting on how personal values and boundaries shape healthy choices.




CAREER EXPLORATION

Staff reviewed Scholars' career assessments and helped Scholars connect their career to a college major and investigate the average income for potential careers. During the H.E.R.O.S. Program, Mentors and Scholars talked about academic and professional goals and learning more about Scholars' chosen fields. Empowerment was used as a foundation to guide reflection, discussion and connection.

LEADERSHIP AND SELF ADVOCACY

Empowerment was introduced during the year. Scholars participated in empowering activities that challenged them to recognize their inner strength and personal power. They reflected on how small victories contribute to greater success, explored what it means to own their voice, and celebrated the courage it takes to grow, persevere, and lead with confidence. Scholars were able to identify their personal leadership style through self-assessment and peer discussion.

YOUR MIND



COLLEGE READINESS

Scholars worked to distinguish between short-term goals and long-term dreams while identifying challenges between balancing academic, social and personal responsibilities. Staff reinforced the need for intentional planning and flexibility in managing a college schedule. Also, equipping Scholars with the self-awareness and skills needed to manage conflict and communicate assertively in college, personal and social settings.

BRIGHT FUTURES AHEAD

The National Bright Futures Survey was developed in partnership with Dr. Philip Hong from the University of Georgia to better understand our scholars' hopes and aspirations as it relates to their academic and future goals. In creating this survey and collecting feedback from scholars, we are embracing the challenge young people face and how we can be better stewards of their emotions and feelings as we support their growth in our Academies!

PEER MENTOR RECOGNITION

First Star recognizes the positive impact peer mentors have on our scholars. The First Star ISU Academy awarded peer mentors for their years of service and unwavering support of the academy.

- 62% are current students or alumni of host university
- 53% identify as first generation
- 17% identify as current or former foster youth
- 11% identify as former First Star scholars



CAREGIVER ENGAGEMENT

First Star ISU Academy hosted Caregiver Orientations and other engagement events on campus during the year.

100% of families at ISU Academy receive monthly check-in's on their scholar's participation in the program and are involved in their student's academic case management meetings.



FOSTER CARE AWARENESS MONTH ADVOCACY

ISU hosted a community stakeholder open house in Spring of 2024 to bring awareness to the on and off campus community.
